## Infants to 1 Year of Age:

**No canned goods or food items and lotions, shampoo use zip lock bag.**

**Many coats and blankets are used in the cold temps and are greatly needed.**

**ALL SHOE BOXES MUST BE PACKED INTO A LARGER CARDBOARD BOX AND  
LABELED FOR CHURCH AND CITY. USE VERY STURDY SHOE BOXES. I WILL PACK  
THEM IN THE HOUSE FOR YOU, BRING THEM IN. MANY OF THEM WERE SMASHED.**

**Guide for shoe box items: Age appropriate. Something fun (toy or such), Hygiene items, Useful ( school supplies), Warm(gloves, stocking hats, scarves, socks) Religious item. You can gift wrap if you chose, suggest wrapping cover separate from bottom and secure with either tape or ribbons. ## Directions to the Hupf Farm for the Semi:

From **US Hwy. 52** to Hampton/47 exit. Turn right on **47** through Hampton, continue for 3 miles to 260 St. turn left, (only a left hand turn, gravel ) go ½ mile , dairy farm on right hand side, big blue shed

(If coming from Farmington, take **MN 50** to Hampton, turn right at flashing light onto **Northfield Blvd.**) to 260<sup>th</sup> St.
