In a land of immense poverty and drought, the mothers of Kitui, Kenya, realize that the answer for future success lies in educating their daughters. However, these young women are faced with a serious lack of safe and secure housing if they wish to continue their education after high school.

The mothers have joined together with the Catholic Women Association (CWA) of Kitui Diocese. They have pledged their meager savings and have begun building a safe dormitory for female students.

As women of the Archdiocese of St. Paul and Minneapolis, let's join together with these mothers in solidarity and prayer to help them realize their goal of building a five-story dormitory!



The Kavonza Dormitory project is being overseen by Caritas International and the Kitui Diocese. It is divided into five building phases with phase two well underway (above photo). There are 7 double apartment units currently occupied with 14 female students (upper photo). Once the project is complete, there will be potential for 220 female students to be housed in modern units with a kitchen, electricity and indoor plumbing.
